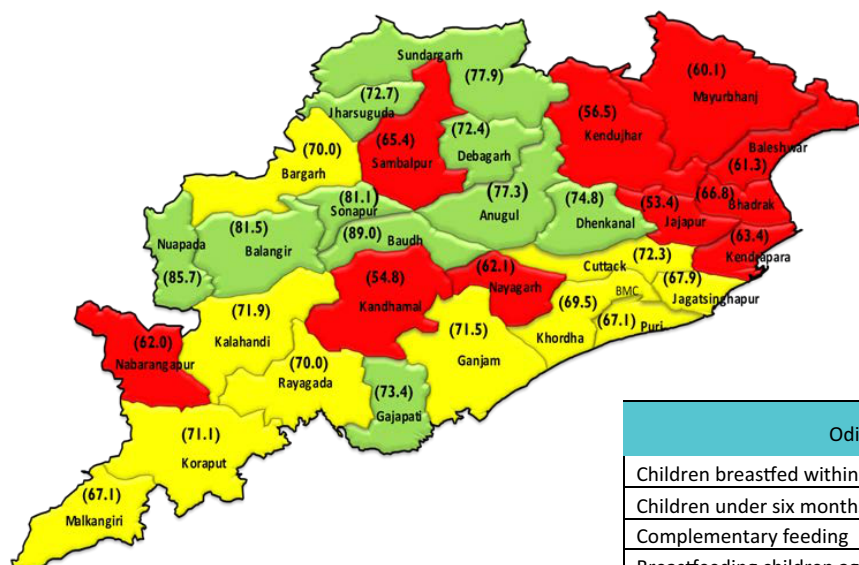

Top performing Districts

89% children in Boudh are breastfed within one hour of birth

Mayurbhanj and Kandhamal ranks top with **81.4%** children exclusively breastfed for six months
